Scholarship Program Purpose

Through this scholarship, we aim to remove financial barriers and enable individuals from diverse backgrounds to access quality education and thrive in the textile industry.

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Applicants who come from backgrounds facing heightened challenges or vulnerabilities will be given preference.
- 2. Applicants must demonstrate a strong interest in pursuing education or training in sewing, textiles, or related fields.
- 3. Eligible courses include:
 - a. Basic Sewing I
 - b. Basic Sewing II
 - c. Intro to Garments
 - d. Advanced Garment Construction
 - e. Entrepreneurial Track
 - f. Registered Apprenticeship Track
 - g. Other courses will be considered if accompanied by a statement outlining how the course falls within the parameters of The Sewing Labs Scholarship Program.

- 4. Applicants must provide evidence of financial need, such as proof of income, eligibility for financial aid, **or** a statement of financial hardship.
- 5. Applicants must submit a completed scholarship application form, including all required documents and information, by the specified deadline.
- 6. Applicants must maintain regular attendance and satisfactory course progress
- 7. Preference may be given to applicants who demonstrate a commitment to community service, leadership, or other extracurricular activities that align with the values of The Lonnie Vanderslice Scholarship Fund.
- 8. Recipients of the scholarship must agree to abide by any additional terms and conditions set forth by The Sewing Labs or the scholarship fund, including but not limited to providing periodic progress updates and participating in promotional activities.

These eligibility requirements serve as a foundation for ensuring that the scholarship fund reaches deserving candidates who embody the spirit of empowerment and dedication exemplified by Lonnie Vanderslice.
