Join our kindred spirit group of sharing/learning the art of quilting. This year the quilt pattern selected is "Interlock" by Amy Friend – this is a fun geometric pattern using jelly roll pre-cut fabrics.

## What to Expect:

<u>Friday Night</u> – Doors open & check in starting @ 5 pm. Gathering starts @ 6 pm. We will gather to get to know each other. Participate in Sew-N-Tell, and have a round table talk. Set-up sewing stations. Quilt Pattern & fabrics will be distributed. Snacks served.

<u>Saturday</u> – Doors open @ 7 am Continental Breakfast available @ 7:30–8am Sewing Room rules & overview explained. Finish sewing Station set up & overview of quilt design explained. Cutting instructions and off we go!!!! Lunch break @ 12 noon – serving thru 1pm. Sewing throughout the day, Dinner served @ 5-6 pm. Trunk show of a selected designer will be following dinner @ approximately 7 pm for those who want to participate. Sewing room open until 10 pm.

Stash Bash – This is a private sale only for the retreat participants. We have gathered a special inventory of fabrics, pre-cuts, kits, notions and more – many vintage sales will support TSL - this will be available all day Saturday & Sunday until noon.

<u>Sunday</u> – Door open @ 7 am Continental Breakfast available from 7:30 - 8am. Sewing & sewing throughout the day. Quick Tips lesson @ 11 am. Roundtable focusing on Gratitude during lunch. Lunch served 12-1. Finishing up & preparing to leave by 2 pm.
