What to Expect:

<u>Friday Night</u> – Doors open & check in starting @ 5 pm. Gathering starts @ 6 pm. We will get to know each other, participate in Sew-N-Tell, and have a round table talk. Quilt Pattern & fabrics will be distributed, and of course, there will be snacks!

<u>Saturday</u> – Doors open @ 8 am, and the Continental Breakfast will be available @ 8 - 9 am. The Sewing Room rules & an overview of the weekend will be presented, with time for Q&A. Then, we will set up the Sewing Stations to get some information about quilt design and cutting instructions and then off we go!!!! Lunch break will be at 12 noon – serving thru 1pm. We will continue sewing throughout the day, with dinner served from 5- 6 pm. After dinner, a selected designer will present her Trunk Show to those who are interested.
