Open Sew – Bring your sewing machine or use ours (first come, first serve). Use our tools & stash to practice your skills or start a project or bring your own project to work. This is an open format with <u>no instructions</u> but, volunteers are available to help. If you have never sewn before – take our Simple Sewing class before coming to Open Sew

Class Fee is FREE

Just Sewcial – Humble Quilts – Do you need a quilt or know someone who does? Come make a "humble" quilt with others. We use simple designs & the materials we have on hand. We piece & quilt as a group together, like a "sewing bee" of the past. Everyone works on 1 quilt at a time to honor the cloth & share the kindness of a warm blanket. FREE but must come to work on the quilt to receive one.

#### Sewing

Simple Sewing - Learn about; seams & seam finishes, sewing tools, measuring & simple construction while making – a book bag, pillowcase &/or zippered pouch. All materials provided. Kid Friendly

1 – 3-hour sessions \$35

Sewing Help for Costume Nerds – Come make your costume at The Sewing Labs! Taught by veteran costumers Alli & Jamie Lindenmann, this class will consist of one 30-minute demonstration each week, followed by 90 minutes of open costume construction. If you know what you want your costume to be, we are here to help you construct it. If you are still in the discovery phase of what you want to do, we are here to help. You can take 1 session or come for all, as there is lots to learn with every class. The course fee will be charged per session, with a discount option for a block of 4 sessions.

1 session \$20 or 4 for \$65

Clothing Repair Workshop – Bring a garment in need of repair – pants to hem, patches needed, missing button or need a new zipper.

This workshop does not cover alterations. Workshop consist of a demonstration of methods of simple repair followed by you working on your own garment – you may need to bring your own materials – call for info

1 session 3 hours \$30

Garments – If you are wanting to sew with patterns – this is the class for you. Beginner & beyond sewing skills welcome. You will choose your own pattern & fabrics with guidance from instructors. Use our stash or bring your own. Re-sign up as many times as you want.

Thursday evenings 6-8 pm

Sessions run 6 weeks - \$ 120

Sewing Machine Operator Basics – Learn to use your new machine or refresh your skills. Bring your machine and all its accessories & tools Workbook included. FREE with any other class enrollment 1 session 3 hours \$30

**Job Skills Training** - all job skills training courses will require testing for certification

Phase 1 – Sewing Basics – This course covers Sewing Machine Operation & Maintenance, Tools Time, Threads & needles, Seams, Hems, closures & more. You will make a tool organizer & samples for future reference 8 – 2 hours sessions \$ 160

Phase 2 – Intro to Garments – This course covers body sizing & silhouette styling, pattern selection, layout, cutting and more. Textile selection. You will make a simple top with darts, gathers or tucks and neckline with facings. (no knit fabrics) 4 – 2 hour session \$ 80

Phase 2 Skirts & Pants – Learn to make skirts &/or pants – you will learn the methods to put in zippers, add waistband with interfacing and finish with hook or button.

Course is in 4-weeks with homework.

4 – 2hour session \$ 80

Industrial Sewing – Speed Sewing – Come to learn some tricks of using an Industrial Straight needle to improve your speed and accuracy.

Master Instructor – Nancy Petersen will guide you in hands-on sewing while making samples for your reference.

2.5 hr. Fee \$35

Quilting Club — Quilted Cross Body Bag — make a fun quilted mixed piece of fabric incorporating; batik fabrics, trims & ribbons, embellishments & quilting — and then construct a personal cross body bag using this fabric. All materials included. 2 -2 hours session \$ 40 Hand Embroidery — Enjoy learning the art of hand embroidery while creating a sampler or other simple project with Brenda Daily. Come weekly to learn new stitches and projects - All materials provided.

1 — 1-hour session \$15
