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

Simple Sewing – Sew a simple project – December – Cloth Napkins to decorate your table. All materials provided. Kid Friendly 1-2 hr. Donations accepted.

Garments – If you are wanting to sew with patterns – this is the class for you. Beginner & beyond sewing skills welcome but sewing machine operator skills needed. You will choose your own pattern & fabrics with guidance from instructors. Use our stash or bring your own. Re-sign up as many times as you want. Thursday evenings 3-5 pm

Sessions run 6 weeks - \$ 120

Sewing Machine Operator Basics – Learn to use your new machine or refresh your skills. Bring your machine and all its accessories & tools Workbook included. FREE with any other class enrollment. (Part of Phase 1 certification)

1 session 2 hours \$25

<u>Job Skills Training</u> - all job skills training courses will require testing for certification

Phase 1 – Sewing Basics – 2 Parts - Includes 6 sessions covering: new fundamental skills each week – see calendar. Tools, Seams & hems & zippers, etc. – you will make reference samples while creating a variety of projects. Homework required Each Part consists of 6 – 2 hours sessions \$ 120

Phase 2 – Intro to Garments – Part 1- Intro to Patterns. This course uses commercial patterns & covers body sizing & silhouette styling, textiles, pattern selection, layout, cutting & more. You will make a simple garment. Do not purchase pattern until after first session.
