The selection covers all kinds of fabrics; fashion fabrics, home decor fabrics, cotton & quilting fabrics. In addition, there will be an assortment of notions, tools, patterns and sewing machines. The selection will also include vintage & newer items. Meet other makers and learn about The Sewing Labs mission to use sewing to create jobs and to build community. Open Sew – Bring your sewing machine or use ours (first come, first serve). Use our tools & stash to practice your skills or start a project or bring your own project to work. This is an open format with <u>no instructions</u> but, volunteers are available to help. If you have never sewn before – take our Simple Sewing class before coming to Open Sew

Class Fee is FREE

SUL- Sewing as a Universal Language – this is a multi-lingual class with a partnership of Don Bosco. Registration must be made thru Don Bosco Senior Center.

Sewing

Simple Sewing - Learn about; seams & seam finishes, sewing tools, measuring & simple construction while making – a book bag, pillowcase &/or zippered pouch. All materials provided. Kid Friendly

1 – 3-hour session \$35

Sewing Help for Costume Nerds – Come make your costume at The Sewing Labs! Taught by veteran costumers Alli & Jamie Lindemann, this class will consist of one 30-minute demonstration each week, followed by 90 minutes of open costume construction. If you know what you want your costume to be, we are here to help you construct it. If you are still in the discovery phase of what you want to do, we are here to help. You can take 1 session or come for all, as there is lots to learn with every class. The course fee will be charged per session, with a discount option for a block of 4 sessions.

1 session \$20 or 4 for \$65

Garments – If you are wanting to sew with patterns – this is the class for you. Beginner & beyond sewing skills welcome. You will choose your own pattern & fabrics with guidance from instructors. Use our stash or bring your own. Re-sign up as many times as you want.

Thursday evenings 6-8 pm

Sessions run 6 weeks - \$ 120

Sewing Machine Operator Basics – Learn to use your new machine or refresh your skills. Bring your machine and all its accessories & tools Workbook included. FREE with any other class enrollment 1 session 3 hours \$30

Job Skills Training - all job skills training courses will require testing for certification

Phase 1 – Sewing Basics – This is a continuation of the course – these sessions cover: Seams & finishes – make reference samples of many while creating bookbag, pillowcases and/or aprons 3 – 2 hours sessions \$ 60

Phase 2 – Intro to Garments – This course covers body sizing & silhouette styling, pattern selection, layout, cutting and more. Textile selection. You will make a simple top with darts, gathers or tucks and neckline with facings. (no knit fabrics) 6 – 2 hour session \$ 120

Phase 2 Skirts & Pants – Learn to make skirts &/or pants – you will learn the methods to put in zippers, add waistband with interfacing and finish with hook or button.

Course is in 4-weeks with homework.

4 – 2hour session \$ 80

Quilting Club —T shirt Quilt— Make a unique quilt from your favorite T shirts. You will learn the tricks to making this quilt. Bring 20 or more T-shirts. Special interfacing supplied & other materials can be used from our stash

5-2 hours session \$ 100

Hand Embroidery – Enjoy learning the art of hand embroidery while creating a sampler or other simple project with Brenda Daily. Come weekly to learn new stitches and projects - All materials provided.

1 – 1-hour session \$15
