<u>Fabric Grab Event – March 12 @ 9am – 2pm</u> – You must attend our semiannual shopping event. FREE FABRIC and almost free!! This is The Sewing Labs stash bash & fundraiser. Fabric, notions, patterns, sewing machines and more – Come early or miss out!

**Open Sew** – Bring your sewing machine or use ours (first come, first serve). Use our tools & stash to practice your skills or start a project or bring your own project to work. This is an open format with no instructions but, volunteers are available to help. **Class Fee is FREE Quick Sew Projects during Open Sew** – **Just a FUN day out to sew.** TSL has a menu of different projects for you to choose from. Most all require sewing – because that is what we do! These projects are Ready-to-go complete with instructions and supplies. Many are "Kid Friendly" (KID)- a great way to pass on the Legacy of Sewing.

We have the machines - we have the tools; cutting, measuring & marking - we have the notions; thread, buttons, etc. Just add you!

- Simple Sewing (SS) take about 1-2 hour basic sewing machine skills
- ➤ Quick Quilting (QS) takes about 1-2 hour uses quilt basic techniques
- ➤ No Sew (NS)— Fun projects with the sewist in mind 1 hour
- Second Skills (2SS) project requires 2<sup>nd</sup> level skills refer to project description up to 2 hours

- ★ Mason Jar Sewing Kit (NS)(KID)- create a pin cushion topped mason jar & fill with sewing supplies \$15

# **Quilting & Fiber Arts**

**Collage Cross Body Bag** – Make a one of a kind bag using batiks, trims appliques. Then embellish with buttons or patches and quilting. Just the right size for your cell phone and cash stash. All other supplies provided.

2– 3 hr. sessions Fee \$40.

**Quilting Club - Tool Totes -** Each month make a different project. In March make a tool caddy for your sewing tools – great for storage to take to your favorite retreat. Or make a sewing machine cover. All supplies provided.

4 -2 hr. sessions Fee \$80.

Miniature Modern Quilt – Treat yourself to a sample of modern quilting with the miniature quilt – small enough to frame for the wall.

Graphic & linear designs. All materials provided

2 – 3 hrs. sessions Fee \$40

**Hand Embroidery** – Enjoy learning the art of hand embroidery while creating a sampler or other simple project with Brenda Daily. Come weekly to learn new stitches and projects - All materials provided.

1 – 1-hour session \$15.

### **Sewing**

Intro to Garments – Learn to sew with commercial patterns. Class covers pattern selection, sizing, pattern layout, cutting marking and more. You will create your reference notebook to use for future sewing. Basic sewing skills recommended. x4 -2 hr. sessions Fee \$80

**Garments** – If you are wanting to sew with patterns – this is the class for you. Beginner & beyond sewing skills welcome. You will choose your own pattern & fabrics with guidance from instructors. For certification, testing is required at end of course. Use our stash or bring your own. Re-sign up as many times as you want. Thursday evenings 6-8 pm

Sessions run 6 weeks for \$ 120

**Sewing Machine Basics** – Learn to use your new machine or refresh your skills. Bring your machine and all its accessories & tools Workbook included. Sessions are scheduled during other classes or can be private.

1 session 3 hours Fee \$30

**Recycle Denim Bags** – Choose from 2 different bags to make using recycle denim from the Lee Jeans company – all materials provided. Workshop is kid friendly but must have adult partner. Beginner sewing skills recommended. Bring a snack

4 hr. Fee \$ 50

#### **Job Skills Training**

Industrial Sewing — Learn the skills to operation several types of commercial machines; straight needle, serger, cover-stitch and more. Skills building for accuracy & speed using working examples, real work-room site tours included. This course is for the person interested in securing employment in sewing. Course consists of class lectures & lab work. First 8 weeks covers the basic straight needle operation. Testing is required for certification. Weekly 2.5hr. instruction, 2 hr. practice lab. \$250/month, \$1500/6 months

Basic Sewing – Phase 1 – Certification – Learn to master a home machine operation, learn to use the tools of the sewing trade, then add the building blocks of sewing; seams, finishes, zippers, closures, buttons and more. Earn a certification thru testing. Then use these skills to start your own business or acquire a job in sewing. All materials provided.

10 sessions of 2 hours \$200.00
