Open Sew – Bring your sewing machine or use ours. Use our tools & stash to practice your skills or start a project or bring your own project to work. This is an open format with no instructions but, volunteers are available to help.

Class Fee is FREE – TSL sewing equipment available first come, first served

<u>Quick Sew Projects during Open Sew</u> – Just a FUN day out to sew. TSL has a menu of different projects for you to choose from. Most all require sewing – because that is what we do! These projects are Ready-to-go complete with instructions and supplies. Many are "Kid Friendly" (KID)- a great way to pass on the Legacy of Sewing.

We have the machines - we have the tools; cutting, measuring & marking - we have the notions; thread, buttons, etc. Just add you!

- Simple Sewing (SS) take about 1-2 hour basic sewing machine skills
- Quick Quilting (QS) takes about 1-2 hour uses quilt basic techniques
- ➤ No Sew (NS)— Fun projects with the sewist in mind 1 hour
- Second Skills (2SS) project requires 2nd level skills refer to project description up to 2 hours

Improv Stack-n-Whack Quilting - Come find out what this trend in quilting is all about. Jane Bromberg, a recognized instructor, will take you step by step to learn the art of Stack-n-Whack. Bring your ugliest fabric to try or use from our stash.

4 -2 hr. sessions Fee \$50

Sewing

Garments & Garments – If you are wanting to sew with patterns – this is the class for you. Beginner & beyond sewing skills welcome. You will choose your own pattern & fabrics with guidance from instructors. For certification, testing is required at end of course. Use our stash or bring your own. Re-sign up as many times as you want. Thursday evenings 6-8 pm

Sessions run 6 weeks for \$ 80

Sewing machine Basics – Learn to use your new machine or refresh your skills. Bring your machine and all its accessories & tools Workbook included. Sessions are scheduled during other classes or can be private.

1 session 3 hours Fee \$25

Serger Machine Operation – Learn to use your Serger or one of ours. Bring your machine and all its accessories & tools.

You will make a sample book for future reference. 2 session 2 hour Fee \$45

<u>Job Skills Training</u> - Commercial Sewing —. Learn the skills to operation several types of commercial machines; straight needle, serger, cover-stitch and more. Skills building for accuracy & speed using working examples, real work-room site tours included. This course is for the person interested in securing employment in sewing. Course consists of class lectures & lab work. First 8 weeks covers the basic straight needle operation. Testing is required for certification. Weekly 2.5hr. instruction, 2 hr. practice lab. Classes to resume in Feb \$250/month, \$1500/6 months
