Quilting & Fiber Arts

Quilting Club -In June TSL will be honored to exhibit at the Kansas City Quilt Festival & Makers Faire – so June 4th & June 11Th volunteers will be prepping for these events.

Walking Foot Quilting – June 18th & July 2nd – Learn the art and technique of using a walking foot & your domestic sewing machine to quilt your quilt. Recognized quilt speaker – Jane Bromberg will walk you thru her tips and tricks to create fun & graphic stitch design with this technique. You will create a sample library for future reference. All materials provided 2 – 2 hr. session \$40

Hand Embroidery – Enjoy learning the art of hand embroidery while creating a sampler or other simple project with Brenda Daily. Come weekly to learn new stitches and projects - All materials provided.

1 – 1-hour session \$15

Sewing

Phase 1 & 2 Sewing Basics – Start our certification program to learn sewing basics & build your skills weekly. To earn a certification, testing is required. Course is in 8-week segments: 8 weeks for Phase 1 and 8 weeks for Phase 2. Syllabus on website 8 -2 hr. sessions -\$160 Garments – If you are wanting to sew with patterns – this is the class for you. Beginner & beyond sewing skills welcome. You will choose your own pattern & fabrics with guidance from instructors. Use our stash or bring your own. Re-sign up as many times as you want. Thursday evenings 6-8 pm

Sessions run 6 weeks - \$ 120

Sewing Machine Basics – Learn to use your new machine or refresh your skills. Bring your machine and all its accessories & tools Workbook included. Sessions are scheduled during other classes or can be private.

1 session 3 hours \$30

Intro to Industrial Sewing — Do you think you want to learn to sew with an Industrial machine? but, want to test drive them before you commit to our full course? This is the class for you. This class will include demonstration & hands on sewing. Taught by Master Instructor — Nancy Petersen. All materials provided.
