## DREAM. SEW. BIG – Capital Campaign for 2020!

**What:** DREAM. SEW. BIG Capital Campaign is off an running for our 2020 expansion of services and relocation/expansion of classroom space. Please consider investing in The Sewing Labs financially in 2020 so that we can support more sewist. We will relocate in late Spring to a larger space to accommodate more sewists and more opportunities for growing jobs and entrepreneurs.

**Open Sew** – Bring your sewing machine or use ours (first come, first serve). Use our tools & stash to practice your skills or start a project or bring your own project to work. This is an open format with no instructions but, volunteers are available to help. If you have never sewn before – take our Simple Sewing class before coming to Open Sew **Class Fee is FREE**

**Sewcial Justice** - This collection of sewist meet to sew items to benefit others. From Homeless Period Project to Welcome Blanket and more. Invitation request required due to the limited space for sewing.

### Sewing

**Simple Sewing** – Sew a simple project – **January – Simple Book Bag** for hauling your stuff. All materials provided. Kid Friendly 1-2 hr. Donations accepted.

**Garments** – If you are wanting to sew with patterns – this is the class for you. Beginner & beyond sewing skills welcome but sewing machine operator skills needed. You will choose your own pattern & fabrics with guidance from instructors. Use our stash or bring your own. Re-sign up as many times as you want. Thursday evenings 3-5 pm **Sessions run 6 weeks - \$ 120**

**Sewing Machine Operator Basics** – Learn to use your new machine or refresh your skills. Bring your machine and all its accessories & tools Workbook included. FREE with any other class enrollment. (Part of Phase 1 certification) **1 session 2 hours \$25**

**Serger Workshop** – Learn to use your serger or one of ours. Bring your machine, book and accessories. You will learn threading, tension and more while making a sample book for future reference. 2 Sessions 1/21 & 1/28 **2 – 2 hours sessions \$40**

**Job Skills Training** - all job skills training courses will require testing for certification

**Phase 1 – Sewing Basics – 2 Parts** - Includes 6 sessions covering: new fundamental skills each week – see calendar. Tools, Seams & hems & zippers, etc. – you will make reference samples while creating a variety of projects. Homework required Each Part consists of **6 – 2 hours sessions \$ 120**

**Phase 2 – Intro to Garments – Part 1- Intro to Patterns.** This course uses commercial patterns & covers body sizing & silhouette styling, textiles, pattern selection, layout, cutting & more. You will make a simple garment. Do not purchase pattern until after first session. **6 – 2-hour session \$ 120**

**Quilting Club** - watch of beginner quilting course in February 2020

**Sew-a-palooza – Sewing Saturday – January Workshop - Denim Field Bag** – join us to make a bag from recycled denim from the Lee Jeans. First quality denim samples to make a unique bag with many pockets for many uses. All materials & hardware provided **1 – 4 hr. session \$55**

**Hand Embroidery** – Enjoy learning the art of hand embroidery while creating a sampler or other simple project with Brenda Daily. Come weekly to learn new stitches and projects - All materials provided. **Watch for Special Projects 1 – 1-hour session \$15**
