<u>Serger Workshop: Mastering Serger Basics</u> (3-part series) Fridays, July 11th - 21st, 5:30pm-8:00pm

Whether you bring your own serger to enhance your skills or use one of our machines, this workshop will equip you with the essential knowledge to effectively utilize a serger.

Moth Plushies: (2-part series) Thursdays, July 10th and 17th, 12:30pm-3:00pm

In this specialized sewing class students will create a whimsical moth/butterfly plush. It's a step-by-step guide to creating your own unique soft, nature inspired plush using repurposed fur piece scraps. 

Dear Zelma,

I where am I going to be able to find affordable garment fabric now that Joann has gone out of business? I am still working through my stash, but I am concerned for my fabric future.

Dear Concerned Fabric Stasher,

I hear you. This is a question we have been getting from a lot of students here at the Labs. Luckily there are alternative sources where you can explore more sustainable and inexpensive fabric buying options.

A great place to start is using the donated fabrics that we have available right here at the Sewing Labs. All students who sign up for a class at The Sewing Labs get 5 pounds of fabric for free!

In Kansas City we also have two creative reuse stores, Scraps KC and Magpie Creative Reuse. They sell fabric, thread, notions, zippers, patterns, etc., all of which have been donated.

You can also find fabric at thrift stores. Thrift stores are also a great place to look for sewing machines. Check out Blessings Abound for sewing machines, all of which have been serviced. You can also use old bedsheets and tablecloths for making mockups of patterns. Thrifting is not guaranteed to yield exactly what you are looking for. The best finds at thrift stores come from consistency and patience.

Another great place to look for fabric is at estate sales. If you go on the last day of an estate sale, they will usually take offers on everything. These can also be good places to find sewing machines.

Don't forget to support our local small businesses: Legacy fabrics specializes in garment fabric, and if they don't have what you are looking for, they can special order it for you! KC Makerspace mostly stocks quilting fabric, but they also have a room full of apparel fabrics, patterns and notions. These fabric shops also happen to be right down the street from each other, so you might as well check out both while you are in the area. They might be a little more expensive than Joann, but their quality is better and if you get on their mailing lists you can find out when they are having sales.

Whatever fabric you choose, remember to pre-wash your fabric before cutting and sewing because some fabrics will shrink!
