

Simple Sewing –Art Travel Notepad – sew simple notebook cover with pocket – notepad included – add your own crayons or pencils –
Kid Friendly – 1-2 hours.

Garments – If you are wanting to sew with patterns – this is the class for you. Beginner & beyond sewing skills welcome but sewing machine operator skills needed. You will choose your own pattern & fabrics with guidance from instructors. Use our stash or bring your own. Re-sign up as many times as you want. Thursday evenings 4 - 6 pm

Sessions run 6 weeks - \$ 120

Sewing Machine Operator Basics – Learn to use your new machine or refresh your skills. Bring your machine and all its accessories & tools Workbook included. FREE with any other class enrollment. (Part of Phase 1 certification)

1 session 2-3 hours \$25

Job Skills Training – These courses start and restart frequently – call to be added to the waitlist. Testing required for certification

Phase 1 – Sewing Basics – Part 1 or Part 2 – Each includes 6 sessions covering new fundamental skills each week – see calendar. you will make samples while creating a variety of projects for future reference. Homework required Each Part consists of 6 – 2 hours sessions \$ 120

Phase 2 – Intro to Garments – Part 1 or Part 2 This course uses commercial patterns & covers body sizing & silhouette styling, textiles, pattern selection, layout, cutting & more. Then onto elements of garments such as textiles, darts, collars, waistbands, sleeves and more. You will make a simple samples of garments components.

Each part consists of 8 – 2-hour session \$ 160

Quilting - Watch for Going Green Project in April

Japanese Boro Stitching — Learn the history & art of Boro Stitching — the mindful art of reusing fabrics and slow stitching. You will make fabric and then use it to construct a beautiful bag. You can bring a treasured garment to repurpose or use our fabrics, included.

3 sessions 3/10, 3/24 & 3/31 - \$60.

Snowman Hand Embroidery — Enjoy learning the art of hand embroidery with Brenda Daily, while creating a fun wall quilt with a snowman center. - February designs is a standing snowman with added quilt blocks around. Homework required to complete. All materials provided.4 – 2 hr. session \$80

Start to Quilt — Learn the fundamentals of quilting while creating a table runner. Course covers; color theory & print selection, basics in cutting with rotary tool system, block construction with proper seam allowance. You will make up to 4 different quilt block patterns while mastering proper construction as well as tips & tricks to sew with confidence. Some homework required. Kits available or bring your own fabrics. (Kits \$ 20.00)

Courses 4 sessions — Tues; 2/11, 2/18, 2/24, 3/3 sessions \$ 80

Sewing Salon – Production Sewing – The Sewing Labs is proud to introduce new opportunities for you to learn to sew with domestic and industrial machines and then to use these skills to work on "live" projects. In addition, there is entrepreneurial skills added so that you start or work a business in sewing. Sewist will be supported with stipends during training. Sewists considered must be committed to the 30-40-week program and attend a minimum of 2 - 3 hr. classes per week. Some homework required.
