Open Sew – Bring your sewing machine or use ours (first come, first serve). Use our tools & stash to practice your skills or start a project or bring your own project to work. No instructions are offered – you must have sewing experience but, volunteers are available to help. This is only available for domestic machines. Limited to 5 persons Class Fee is FREE

<u>Literacy KC/Don Bosco- Sewing as a Second Language</u> - Training - closed classes - enrollment available thru Literacy KC

Shibori Fabric Dyeing Workshop - In this class you will learn the Japanese art of Arashi (pole wrapping.) It is one of many techniques under the umbrella of Shibori, which mean shape resist dyeing. Shibori is a Japanese term for several methods of dyeing cloth with a pattern by binding, stitching, folding, twisting, or compressing it. All materials and dyes are included 1 session 3 hrs. \$65

Sewing

Garments – If you are wanting to sew with patterns – this is the class for you. Beginner & beyond sewing skills welcome. Must have sewing machine operator skills for this class. You will choose your own pattern & fabrics with guidance from instructors. Use our stash or bring your own. Re-sign up as many times as you want. Thursday evenings 6-8 pm Sessions run 6 weeks for \$ 120

Sewing Machine Basics – Learn to use your new machine or refresh your skills. Bring your machine and all its accessories & tools Workbook included. Sessions are scheduled during other classes or can be private. 1 session 3 hours Fee \$30

Fall Poncho – Make a quick & fun Poncho in time for Fall – selection of materials available or bring your own 1 session 3 hrs. - Fee \$45

Origami Bag – Make a unique origami bag for fun and fashion – all materials provided

1 session 3 hrs. - Fee \$45

Job Skills Training

Industrial Basics -

- M/TH class held 2 times per week & is part of our "Salon" program which includes up to 40 weeks covering Industrial, Domestic, & Entrepreneurial courses. This course is for the person interested in securing employment or entrepreneurship in sewing. Learn the skills to operation several types of industrial machines: straight needle, serger, cover-stitch and more. Skills building for accuracy & speed using real work samples, real work-room site tours included. Course consists of class lectures & lab work& homework. Includes Tool Kit & materials Fee \$175/monthly or \$1520
- A or B class held 1 time per week for 8 weeks Up your sewing game by learning to operate and industrial straight needle & serger while making simple projects 8 sessions 2.5 hrs. Fee \$300

Industrial Sewing Machine Rental – coming in November – NEW!!

Industrial Machine Operator & Safety – New to The Sewing Labs – if you are wanting to rent an Industrial sewing machine @ TSL you will be required to take this 1 session course to review the basic operation & safety of straight & serger industrial machines. This course is held monthly, and it must be completed BEFORE machine rental is allowed 1 session – 3 hrs. Fee \$ 60

Basic Sewing - Phase 1 - Certification - Learn to master a home machine operation, learn to use the tools of the sewing trade, then add the building blocks of sewing, seams, finishes, zippers, closures, buttons and more. Earn a certification thru testing. Then use these skills to start your own business or acquire a job in sewing. All materials provided. 10 sessions of 2 hours \$200.00

Entrepreneurial – Virtual format - Do you want to start a business in sewing? Dr. Patricia Eisele will lead you each month to learn different aspects of running your own sewing business from business structure, accounting, marketing and more. In addition, local creative business professionals will share their stories of success. This is part of our "Salon" program but can also be taken separately.

2 – 90 m sessions monthly with homework - Fee \$ 45
